



Sermon.

Speaker: Buster Brown, Senior Pastor Message: People of Truth

Text: Micah 3:5-12, 6:6-8

"⁵Thus says the Lord concerning the prophets who lead my people astray, who cry 'Peace' when they have something to eat, but declare war against him who puts nothing into their mouths. ⁶Therefore it shall be night to you, without vision, and darkness to you, without divination. The sun shall go down on the prophets, and the day shall be black over them; ⁷the seers shall be disgraced, and the diviners put to shame; they shall all cover their lips, for there is no answer from God. ⁸But as for me, I am filled with power, with the Spirit of the Lord, and with justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression and to Israel his sin. ⁹Hear this, you heads of the house of Jacob and rulers of the house of Israel, who detest justice and make crooked all that is straight, ¹⁰WHO BUILD ZION WITH BLOOD AND JERUSALEM WITH INIQUITY. ¹¹Its heads give judgment for a bribe; its priests teach for a price; its prophets practice divination for money; yet they lean on the Lord and say, 'Is not the Lord in the midst of us? No disaster shall come upon us.' ¹²Therefore because of you Zion shall be plowed as a field; Jerusalem shall become a heap of ruins, and the mountain of the house a wooded height." Micah 3:5-12

"'With what shall I come before the Lord, and bow myself before God on high? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old? ⁷Will the Lord be pleased with [a] thousands of rams, with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?' ⁸He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, [b] and to walk humbly with your God." Micah 6:6-8

1. We walk before the God who has spoken and who brings human flourishing or withholds His blessing (3:4). THEREFORE, we will live as called out disciples of Jesus (3:12). Pilgrim solemnly responded to those at Vanity Fair "we buy the truth."

- Life is a sacred gift from the Lord (3:10); THEREFORE, 2. the sanctity of human life is a hinge/linchpin issue. In light of this we prayerfully support ministries and individuals who advocate or defend life from conception until natural death (Baptist Faith and Message, Article 15), as they live out the realities of that world view.
- We are to live and speak the truth of Holy Scripture; THEREFORE, we will do so with the sense of utter dependence upon the Lord as we pray as we desire to embody justice, mercy, and humility. 3:8, 6:7-8.

- Why were the Hutus in Rwanda in 1994 able to cry out "kill the cockroaches" as they put to death more than seven hundred thousand Tutsis (Rwanda and a Nation of 10 Million People)? How is that being manifested today?
- How does 1 Peter 3:15 give understanding to concepts in Micah 6:8?

Eeadership

Deacons

The word "deacon" means servant and came to be used by the church to designate a special position in the church. The deaconship, therefore, signifies a position of special Christian service. Both the Scripture and the dignity of the office demand a person of the highest spiritual, moral, and practical qualifications. The qualifications are listed in 1 Timothy 3:8-13 and are similar to those for elders with the exception of "able to teach."

Elders

Elders (also translated as "overseers") are responsible for overseeing their local church. Their primary duties include leading, teaching, praying and shepherding the people. The Bible lays out clear qualifications for elders in 1 Timothy 3:1-10 and Titus 1:6-9. These qualifications are living above reproach, faithful to his wife, self-controlled temperament, prudent, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, free from addictions, not pugnacious, uncontentious, free from the love of money, manages his household well, not a new convert, gives generously to his church, has a good reputation with outsiders, not self-willed, not quicktempered, loves what is good, just, devout, and one who holds fast the faithful word.
