March

- 3/4 = Matthew 9:36 = "When He saw the crowds, He had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd."
- 3/11 = Matthew 8:27 = "And the men marveled, saying, 'What sort of man is this, that even winds and sea obey Him?'"
- 3/18 = Matthew 15:32 = "Then Jesus called His disciples to Him and said, 'I have compassion on the crowd because they have been with me now three days and have nothing to eat. And I am unwilling to send them away hungry, lest they faint on the way.'"
- 3/25 = Matthew 21:9 = "And the crowds that went before Him and that followed Him were shouting, 'Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!'"

April

- 4/1 = Matthew 28:6 = "He is not here, for He has risen, as he said. 'Come, see the place where He lay.'"
- 4/8 = Judges 2:16 = "Then the Lord raised up judges, who saved them out of the hand of those who plundered them."

- 4/15 = Judges 5:3 = "Hear, O kings; give ear, O princes; to the Lord I will sing; I will make melody to the Lord, the God of Israel."
- 4/22 = Judges 6:16 = "And the Lord said to him, 'But I will be with you, and you shall strike the Midianites as one man.'"
- 4/29 = Proverbs 8:33 = "Hear instruction and be wise, and do not neglect it."
