# Proposed Student Life Center

What will ECBC Members be voting on next Sunday, August 19?

ECBC members will vote on this proposed project via bulletin tear-off next Sunday. Here is a sample of the ballot initiatives:

- Approval to add to physical footprint of the campus
- Proceed with project with \$4mm cash and \$4mm in pledges
- Up to \$1mm in long term debt (PCA to cover debt)
- Short Term Financing of the pledges during the construction phase



## **Proposed Project:**

Over the past couple of years, leadership has assessed the needs of our student ministries, especially the growth of Palmetto Christian Academy. They have determined the need to expand the church's campus to include a Student Life Center. The proposed building is essentially a large rectangle built using engineered pre-fab sections. The total cost of the project is \$8 million which includes a contingency to prevent budget overages.

### **Proposed Funding:**

PCA has raised a total of \$3.2 million in cash and pledges with \$1.6 million cash onhand and \$1.6 million in pledges. The proposal for funding and to begin the project is to secure a total of \$4 million in cash and \$4 million in pledges.

Proposed timeline for construction from start to finish once project begins is 9-12 months.




