

Today's Message: Living with Intentionality: Know Your Environment/Season of Time

**Today's Text:** Ephesians 5:15-17

"Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, 16 making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. 17 Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is." Ephesians 5:15-17

If I am to live with intentionality to the glory of God, the benefit of others, and my joy, I must have a renewed mind which leads to life patterns, understand my environment, and embrace community.




