Questions for Discussion:

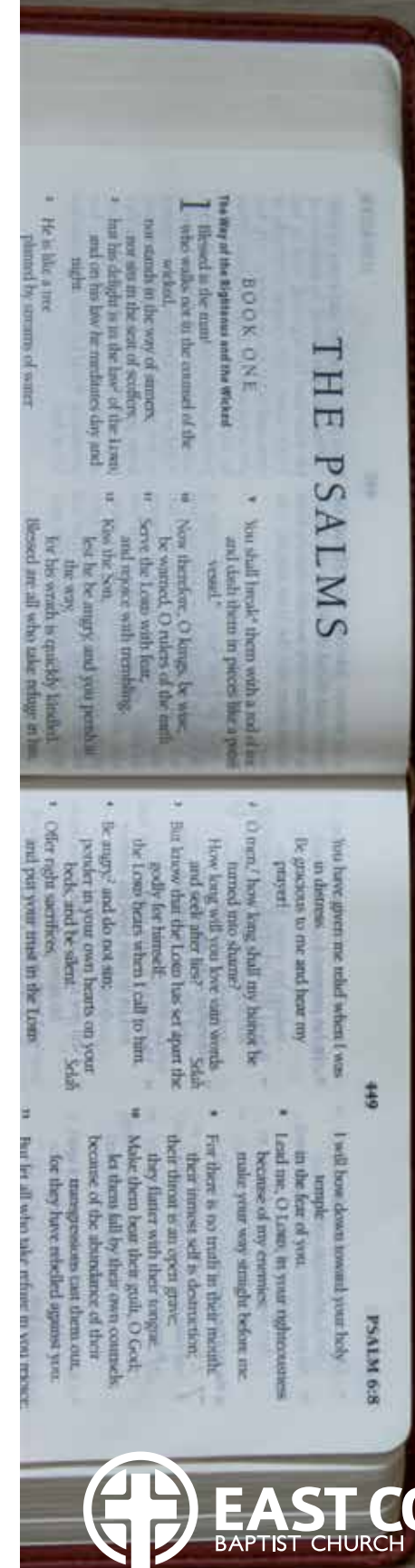
1. When are you most typically oblivious to God's majesty in the world around you and in your day-to-day life? What are some practical ways you can notice the majesty more?
