Position Summary

PCA is seeking an Upper School Principal to serve as the educational leader for Grades 6-12, responsible for supervising and coordinating the activities of approximately 25 faculty members. The Principal's duties include (but are not limited to):

- · Working with Administrative team to develop school-wide procedures and policies
- Working with Administrative team to develop Upper School budget
- Working with Administrative team to maintain ACSI Accreditation
- Assist the Admissions Director in conducting prospective family interviews
- Working with the Lower School Principal to develop class schedules
- Working with Curriculum & Instruction Specialist to develop Upper School curriculum
- Working with Curriculum & Instruction Specialist to evaluate faculty instruction to suggest/ implement new instructional methods
- Using data analysis to assist in student academic improvement and placement
- Communicating with students and parents regarding academic and discipline issues
- Providing ongoing evaluation to faculty members including informal and formal assessments
- Guiding students to self-governance through redemptive discipline
- Providing spiritual leadership and growth opportunities to faculty and staff

Candidate must possess a Master's degree (or higher), or be actively pursing a Master's degree in education or education-related field, from an accredited university and have a minimum of three years of classroom teaching experience. Previous experience as an educational administrator in a Christian school is preferred. Candidate should also have a credible profession of faith and testimony, and be actively involved in a local church, as this person will serve as a role model in attitude, speech, and actions for the school community. The ability to articulate his/her Christian worldview and philosophy of Kingdom education is critical. Candidate must possess excellent written and oral communication skills, and use the Matthew 18 principle for conflict resolution.
