Today's Text: Colossians 4:5-7

“Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person. Tychicus will tell you all about my activities. He is a beloved brother and faithful minister and fellow servant in the Lord.” **Colossians 4:5-7**

Tychicus:

1. Beloved (*cherished, prized*) brother
2. Faithful (*inspiring trust, worthy of requiring responsibility*) minister (*one who attends to the needs of others*)
3. Fellow servant (i.e. servant of Christ)

Onesimus:

1. Faithful (*inspiring trust*)
2. Beloved (*cherished, prized*) brother
